

## Joyful Mysteries

Hint: Picture these first set of symbols as human forms

1. The Annunciation, Luke 1:28 - Fruit of the mystery: Humility.  
The symbol represents the angel Gabriel and Mary
2. The Visitation, Luke 1:41-42 - Fruit of the mystery: Love of Neighbor.  
Symbol represents Elizabeth and Mary extending hands to greet each other
3. The Birth of Jesus, Luke 2:7 - Fruit of the mystery: Poverty.  
Symbol represents the Holy family
4. The Presentation, Luke 2:22-23 - Fruit of the mystery: Obedience.  
Symbol is of Joseph and Mary presenting Jesus to the Lord
5. Finding Jesus in the Temple, Luke 2:46 - Fruit of the mystery: Joy in finding Jesus. Symbol is of Mary and Joseph finding Jesus at 12 yrs. old (and center of the family) in the temple

## Luminous Mysteries

1. The Baptism of Jesus, Matthew 3:16-17 - Fruit of the mystery: Openess to the Holy Spirit. Symbol represents Jesus being baptised
2. Wedding at Cana, John 2:5-7 - Fruit of the mystery: To Jesus through Mary. Symbol represents jar from which water was changed to wine
3. Proclaiming the Kingdom, Matthew 10:7-8 - Fruit of the mystery: Repentance and Trust in God.  
The cross represents holiness and the triangle represents heaven.
4. The Transfiguration, Luke 9:29,35 - Fruit of the mystery: Desire for Holiness. The symbol represents Jesus illuminated and transfigured
5. Institution of the Eucharist, Luke 22:19-20 - Fruit of the mystery: Adoration. The symbol is of the body and blood of Christ

## Sorrowful Mysteries

1. The Agony in the Garden, Luke 22:44-45 - Fruit of the mystery: Sorrow for Sin. The symbol represents agony in drops of blood.
2. Scourging at the Pillar, John 19:1 - Fruit of the mystery: Purity  
The symbol represents the pillar
3. Crowning with Thorns, Matthew 27:28-29 - Fruit of the mystery: Courage. The symbol represents the crown of thorns.
4. Carrying the Cross, John 19:17 - Fruit of the mystery: Patience  
The symbol of a tipped cross represents carrying the cross
5. The Crucifixion, Luke 23:46 - Fruit of the mystery: Perseverance.  
The cross represents the crucifixion

## Glorious Mysteries

1. The Resurrection, Mark 16:6 - Fruit if the mystery: Faith  
The symbol represents the tomb from which Jesus ressurected
2. The Ascension, Mark 16:19 - Fruit of the mystery: Hope  
Symbol represents God (the Son) ascending into heaven with God (the Father) and the Holy Spirit, making up the Trinity (represented as a triangle).
3. Descent of the Holy Spirit, Acts 2:4 - Fruit of the mystery: Love of God. The symbol represents the Holy Spirit as tongues of fire.
4. The Assumption, Judith 15:9-10 - Fruit of the mystery: Grace of a Happy Death. The symbol is of a half moon for the earth and of a triangle for heaven, symbolizing Mary's Assumption from earth to heaven
5. The Coronation, Revelation 12:1 - Fruit of the mystery: Trust in Mary's Intercession. The crown represents the crowning of Mary, Queen of Heaven.
